As the only regulator (now past) in the country who holds a DREI, I am also aware of the rigors of achieving that designation. The DREI standards are similar to many of the requirements of a state's laws, but in addition include a personal teaching audition. Passing laws that would include the DREI as a means of achieving state instructor certification would be a very sound and reasonable idea for a state to consider.

Creating Excellence in Instruction



This designation was designed by the Real Estate Educators Association to recognize excellence among real estate instructors. It is awarded only to those REEA members who demonstrate outstanding real estate knowledge, experience, and classroom performance.

The DREI program is administered by the DREI Leadership Council which is chosen by the DREI membership.

Requirements for Earning the DREI Designation

- 1. Complete the DREI Designation Application.
- 2. Pay the Program Fee.
- 3. Complete the Coaching & Mentoring Program.
- 2. Pass a written examination.
- 3. Submit and pass the Class Presentation Video.



GAPE: Generally Accepted Principles of Education

Generally Accepted Principles of Education (GAPE) are the criteria used to evaluate candidates' teaching skill.

The 5 GAPE categories are:

- Knowledge
- Andragogy
- Speech
- Teaching Aids
- Learning Environment
