### 1. Is the conference going to be held as scheduled?

As of this writing, and until further notice, the REEA Board of Directors has decided to hold fast to our original schedule. If anything changes, you will be notified immediately.

### 2. Why isn't the conference being postponed because of the current situation?

The Board has decided that as of right now, our conference is far enough out that there is not an imminent need to make any significant changes. Kris Inman, our Executive Director is monitoring the situation very closely, is communicating consistently with our event planner and the hotel, and everything thus far is business as usual.

### 3. If I register for the conference and find that I cannot attend, what will happen to my registration fee?

If your cancellation is due to health reasons or concerns, then you can receive a full refund for your registration. If you are unsure if your situation would qualify for a full refund, feel free to contact Kris Inman and discuss your situation.

### 4. If I register and the conference dates are changed and I can't attend, what will happen to my registration fee?

You would receive a full refund for your registration.

### 5. What if I registered for any or all of the Gold Standard IDW's "Instructor Development Workshops" and the classes are postponed?

You would receive a full refund of your IDW registration if you cannot attend the alternative.

### 6. The cancellation policy on the registration form differs from what is stated above. Which one prevails?

This new decision by your Board of Directors made on 3/18/2020, supersedes what is currently on your registration cancellation notice and registration fee will be 100% refundable.
