



## REEA Gold Standard Leader “GSL” Certification Quick Checklist

The **REEA Gold Standard Leader “GSL”** certification was created exclusively by the Real Estate Educators Association “REEA” to set the standard for excellence in real estate classroom instruction. Regulators and others can be assured that a real estate educator who has earned a REEA GSL certification will exhibit a mastery of subject matter, proven presentation ability, relevant experience, and superior teaching skills. The REEA GSL program is administered by the REEA GSL Review Committee which is composed of REEA Executive Staff, Course Designers, and Education Committee Chair who is appointed by the REEA President. The REEA GSL approval qualifies certified REEA Gold Standard Instructor “GSI” holders to teach REEA GSI IDW (Instructor Development Workshop) courses locally and to promote REEA membership. The principles of REEA GSI IDWs are founded in active learning and relevant interactive classroom activities (live or virtual) to increase learning retention. The process to become a REEA Gold Standard Leader (REEA GSL) involves eight easy steps which can be found in detail on the REEA GSL Candidate Application.

Simple checklist of items (*listed alphabetically*) required to earn your REEA GSL Certification include:

- REEA Confidentiality Policy & Agreement, *signed and dated*
- REEA Conflict of Interest Form, *signed and dated*
- REEA GSL Code of Conduct, *signed and dated*
- REEA GSL Instructor Agreement, *completed, signed, and dated*
- REEA GSL Candidate Application, *completed, signed, and dated*
- REEA Non-Disclosure Statement, *signed and dated*
- REEA GSL Instructor Agreement, *completed, signed, and dated*
- REEA GSL Policy & Procedures, *completed, signed, and dated*
- REEA GSL Performance Improvement Plan, *completed, signed, and dated*
- Referrals/Recommendations
- Attendance at both REEA GSI #1 and #2 as a refresher, taking your own personal Instructor notes
- Attendance at REEA GSL Train-the-Trainer “TTT” session
- Submit a 15-minute video of you teaching a real estate related class within the last six-months for review by the REEA GSL review committee.
- Submit REEA GSL Instructor application to REEA Headquarters along with your \$25.00 non-refundable Application Review fee through our Members Only to REEA and all related documents listed in the application.

*Notifications will be sent out for REEA GSI classes to be presented as they become available. If you have not taken Refresher classes of REEA GSI #1 and #2 at this time, you may take them in the future as a refresher. You are not required to have taken the refreshers in order to attend the REEA GSL Train-the-Trainer “TTT” class.*
